

a friend went on in Kenya




# Picture It!



The Mosque in Mali and Addis Ababa in Ethiopia



According to Encarta Encyclopedia, despite the many influences on Africa, the countries have maintained their original practices:

- Indigenous religions remain widely practiced throughout sub-Saharan Africa. Many countries more than 20 percent of the population practice indigenous religions, and in some—notably Liberia, Benin, Sierra Leone, Central African Republic, and Mozambique—more than 50 percent

Some sources say that there are over 800 languages spoken in Africa while other claim it is closer to 1,800 languages
